Revision to Clause 3 of the 2016-2017 Provider Compliance Addendum added this language: *To demonstrate compliance with the above requirements, the provider must submit a signed statement that they understand and will follow the requirement(s) in the future. In addition to providing a signed statement, LNL providers who fail to report changes that would require a new background study can correct the requirement by completing a new background study. If the background study is not approved, an overpayment may result. If Mille Lacs County makes the decision to close a provider registration and a provider corrects a requirement prior to the end of the 15-day notice period, then the registration will be reinstated. If a provider corrects a requirement after their registration closes, then they must re-register using the appropriate Provider Registration form DHS-7195, DHS-5191 or DHS 5192 and submit for approval*

Revision: to Clause 5 of the 2016-2017 Provider Compliance Addendum added this language:

To demonstrate compliance with the above requirements, the provider must submit a signed statement that they understand and will follow the requirement(s) in the future.

If the county makes the decision to close a provider registration and a provider corrects a requirement prior to the end of the 15-day notice period, then the registration will be reinstated. If a provider corrects a requirement after their registration closes, then they must re-register using the appropriate Provider Registration form DHS-7195, DHS-5190, DHS-5191 or DHS-5192 and submit for approval.

Revision: to Clause 6 of the 2016-2017 Provider Compliance Addendum added this language:

To demonstrate compliance with the above requirements, the provider must submit a signed statement that they understand and will follow the requirement(s) in the future.
